Kids Camp at The Council is a three-day prevention and support program that helps kids learn they are not alone and that other kids and families have similar experiences.

Through art, games, role-play and fun activities, kids learn to identify and express feelings, develop self-care skills and deepen communication with their parents.



Parents or caregivers join their children for a portion of the program. This includes parent education and support. All services are provided in a safe and confidential setting.

Above all, children learn that addiction is not their fault.
