We currently need volunteers with skills in several different areas, including:

To work with us, you need to be genuine and support our treatment philosophy. And, of course, we expect you to possess skills relevant to the position you're applying for (including certification, when needed). Finally, because of the nature of the services we provide, volunteer positions do not typically have direct client contact due to licensing requirements, we might ask you to submit to a background check and/or drug screening and sign a statement of confidentiality.
